Museum of the Czechoslovakian fortification



Artillery fortification BOUDA is a cultural monument of the Czech Republic and an integrated part of the extended system of fortifications built to defend the former Czechoslovakia during the second half of the 30s. It consists of five mighty bastions (three infantry blocks, one artillery block and the entrance block), which were built to the strongest level of construction. Deep inside the mountain, the blocks are connected by an external system of tunnels and caverns, which contained everything the garrison of 316 carefully selected and specially trained soldiers of the border guard needed to accomplish their combat task. Museum of Artillery Torun, Poland



Museum of Artillery in Torun was established on the basis of special order of the commander of Military College of Rocket and Artillery in Torun dated 14 January 1977. The museum exhibits are artillery devices not so long ago was in use as an educational equipment for school training. The Museum continues — through its development — the traditions deriving from the interwar period when according to the decision of the Head of General Staff Marshal Józef Piłsudski dated 1923 the Military College of Artillery was appointed in Torun. For the purpose of training the Artillery Museum was founded as well. Museum exhibits and archives did not survive the Second World War. The purpose of the present-day museum is to conduct educational activities and to collect items on the history of Polish and world's military and the history of artillery and weapons. [READ MORE](#)
