#### INTRODUCTORY REMARKS

16. The meeting was called to order by the Chair at 1000 hours Central Standard Time.

2. <u>Ite</u> agenda a	No action required	
3. <u>Ite</u> following	<u>m 3 – 1 RCHA Update</u> . LCol O'Donnell provided the update:	No action required
а.	The Regiment participated with a reduced sized contingent on Ex STRONG CONTENDER, the brigade winter sports competition. B Battery was on post deployment leave after returning from Latvia.	
b.	The Regiment just competed a Regiment School training cycle culminating with Ex FROZEN GUNNER. It was a great opportunity for junior leaders to gain experience and hone theirs soldier skills in winter operations. Many personnel had the opportunity to fill the leadership role of their superior.	
c.	The Regiment is currently on Spring Break and upon return, there will be a smaller individual training period followed by fire fighter training for the upcoming IRU tasking.	

- d. Throughout the spring and summer, the Regiment will conduct some adventure training in Canmore, Alberta in addition to Ex TOUGH GUNNER; a forced march based competition to include a number of obstacles. On Artillery Day, 26 May, the Regiment will conduct a Spring Ball.
- e. The Regiment is currently renewing a number of wall paintings within the regimental lines. They project will be complete before the RCA reunion this spring.
- f. Op PALACI (Avalanche Control in Roger's Pass, BC) will be a 3<sup>rd</sup> Canadian Division task for 2023-2024.
- g. The Senate's cash prizes donated to Ex HEAVY LOADER were well received by the troops. The notion of a cash prize permits the troops the flexibility to purchase whatever they need.

4. <u>Item 4 – Commander Home Station (Comd Home Stn) Update</u>. No action required LCol Wood provided the following update:

- a. The incoming Base Commander will be LCol David Cronk from the Lord Strathcona's Horse. His COS date will be 21 June and the Change of Command is scheduled for 26 June. LCol Wood will be posted to the Strategic Joint Staff (SJS) in Ottawa. There is also a possibility that the Base RSM may change.
- b. The RCA Band will be visiting Shilo on 28 May 2023. They will be conducting an appreciation concert to help recruiting.
- c. 26<sup>th</sup> Fd Regt (with its Band and Recruiter) will be supporting the Royal Manitoba Winter Fair.
- d. CWO Abrahamse was able to meet with the RSM RCA, CWO Normand in mid March.

5. <u>Item 5 – C Coy, 3rd Canadian Division Training Centre Update</u>. No action required Major Jackson provided the following update in the absence of Major Marshall:

- a. C Coy recently completed a Primary Leadership Qualification (PLQ) course graduating 36 candidates and an Infantry Platoon Commanders course graduating 19 candidates. The leadership is currently planning to support up to 7 courses throughout the summer. Staff shortages will be a key factor in determining which courses will be supported. Staff checks to combine courses such as the Engineer Junior Leaders Course (JLC) with the Gunner JLC courses are ongoing.
- b. Canadian Forces Leadership and Recruit School (CFLRS) can now maintain its capacity to conduct training and is no longer exporting courses to the three services.
- c. LCol Wood added that one of his biggest challenges as the Base Commander is providing the best possible support to lodger units in a lean environment. He further added that it is not yet to the point where he needs the Senate to advocate on his behalf.

6. <u>Item 6 – RHQ RCA Update</u>. There was no representation from RHQ at the meeting, and therefore no update.

7. <u>Item 7 – Approval of the Previous Minutes</u>. The Chair stated No action required that the previous minutes have been approved and posted on the RCA website in both English and French.

As a result, it is requested that 1 RCHA have their list of initiatives prepared and prevetted for Non-Public Funds (NPF) compliance by the Treasurer prior to the meeting.
- <u>The History of CFB Shilo</u>. The Chair noted that the history of Shilo has not been updated in quite some time, and that he has a pictorial history that could be brought forward as a starting point for a possible Stag article.
  <u>Secretarial Note</u>: The Chair provided copies of the article and accompanying imagery to both the CO of 1 RCHA and the Comd Home Stn.
- c. The CO 1RCHA indicated that he would add this material CO 1RCHA to another initiative within the regiment to produce the article.
- d. The Base Commander added that he would be able to Comd Home Stn provide translation support for the article.
