
## Bergen General Cemetery/Cimetière général de Bergen



Bergen is on the coast 6 kilometres north-west of Alkmaar and 43 kilometres north-north-west of Amsterdam, lying 3 kilometres west of the main Alkmaar-Den Helder road. The cemetery is on the north-eastern outskirts of Bergen, in the road known as Kerkedijk. The Commonwealth plots are in the south-eastern part of the cemetery.

Bergen se trouve sur la côte à 6 kilomètres au nord-ouest d'Alkmaar et à 43 kilomètres au nord-nord-ouest d'Amsterdam, à 3 kilomètres à l'ouest de la route principale Alkmaar-Den Helder. Le cimetière se trouve à la périphérie nord-est de Bergen, sur la route connue sous le nom de Kerkedijk. Les parcelles du Commonwealth se trouvent dans la partie sud-est du cimetière.



## Bergen-op-Zoom Canadian War Cemetery/Cimetière de guerre canadien de Bergen-op-Zoom



Bergen-op-Zoom is a town in the Dutch province of Noord-Brabant, 40 kilometres north-west of Antwerp (Belgium). Bergen-op-Zoom War Cemetery and Bergen-op-Zoom Canadian War Cemetery are almost next to one another, 3 kilometres east of the town centre, on a road named Ruytershoveweg, which runs parallel with the A58 Bergen-op-Zoom to Roosendaal motorway. The

cemetery can be reached from the motorway by taking the Bergen-op-Zoom exit, which leads on to Rooseveltlaan. At the first crossroads the cemetery is signposted to the right. There is a further signposted right turn after 1 kilometre, and the cemeteries are 1.5 kilometres along this road on the left-hand side.

Bergen-op-Zoom est une ville de la province néerlandaise du Brabant septentrional, à 40 kilomètres au nord-ouest d'Anvers (Belgique). Le cimetière de guerre de Bergen-op-Zoom et le cimetière de guerre canadien de Bergen-op-Zoom sont presque l'un à côté de l'autre, à 3 kilomètres à l'est du centre-ville, sur une route nommée Ruytershoveweg, parallèle à l'A58 Bergen-op-Zoom en direction de Roosendaal autoroute. Le cimetière est accessible depuis l'autoroute en prenant la sortie Bergen-op-Zoom, qui mène à Rooseveltlaan. Au premier carrefour, le cimetière est indiqué à droite. Après 1 kilomètre, il y a un autre virage à droite indiqué et les cimetières se trouvent à 1,5 kilomètre le long de cette route, sur le côté gauche.

The Groesbeek Memorial stands in the Groesbeek Canadian War Cemetery about ten kilometres southeast of the Dutch town of Nijmegen. It commemorates, by name, those members of the Commonwealth land forces who died during the campaign in Northwest Europe between the time of crossing the Seine at the end of August 1944 and the end of the war in Europe. The village of Groesbeek is in the east of the Netherlands and approx

10kms south east of the city of Nijmegen. From the A73 motorway Nijmegen to Venlo take exit 3 (Afrif 3) Malden / Groesbeek / Mook / Heumen / Overasselt. Follow signs for N271 Mook. Continue through the village of Molenhoek and in the village of Mook turn left at the roundabout (CWGC sign for Mook War Cemetery) onto the Groesbeekseweg. Continue for approx 4.5kms and then turn left at the roundabout onto the Pannenstraat. Continue through the town where the road name changes to DORPSTRAAT. Turn left onto Burgemeester Ottenhoffstraat (CWGC Sign). After approx 100m turn right (CWGC sign) onto Zevenheuvelenweg. The cemetery is approx 2kms along this road on the right. 



Turn right onto N276 direction Sittard-Zuid and continue for approx 1km. Turn right Sittard Zuid / Geleen and follow the signs for Sittard Zuid. Turn left

onto Rijksweg Zuid and continue for approx 1km, passing under the railway bridge. Turn right (CWGC sign) onto Geuweg and after 50m turn right (CWGC sign) onto Kromstraat. The cemetery can be found after approx 400m on the right.
